IN CLUB TRANSFERS BETWEEN TEAMS - NO POACHING RULE

The procedures and policies relating to in-club transfers of players between teams are as follows:

- A. Requests for In-Club transfers must be accompanied by a fully completed and appropriately executed transfer form. Transfers will not be effective until all approvals and signatures have been obtained and the approved transfer form is filed with the Club Administrative Secretary.
- B. Any Intramural Team may transfer an Intramural Player to another Intramural Team, if (a) the coach of the Intramural Team from which the Intramural Player is to be transferred, confers with, and receives the approval of, the parents of the Intramural Player and that coach approves of the transfer, (b) the coach of the Intramural Team from which the Intramural Player is to be transferred confers with, and receives the approval of, the coach of the Intramural Team to which the Intramural Player is to be transferred, and (c) then and only then, both coaches confer with the Division Commissioner. In the event that the Division Commissioner declines to permit the requested transfer, that decision is final and is not subject to appeal to the Girls Coordinator, the Boys Coordinator, the Board or any Officer of the Club. In the event that the Division Commissioner approves the requested transfer, the Girls Coordinator or the Boys Coordinator, as the case may be, must approve the transfer before it can be implemented. In the event that the Girls Coordinator or the Boys Coordinator declines to permit the transfer, that decision is final and is not subject to appeal to the Board or any Officer of the Club. Each Intramural Team will be entitled to one transfer per season.
- C. Any Interleague Team may transfer an Interleague Player to another Interleague Team, if (a) the coach of the Interleague Team from which the Interleague Player is to be transferred, confers with, and receives the approval of, the parents of the Interleague Player and that coach approves of the transfer, (b) the coach of the Interleague Team from which the Interleague Player is to be transferred confers with, and receives the approval of, the coach of the Interleague Team to which the Interleague Player is to be transferred, and (c) then and only then, both coaches confer with the Division Commissioner. In the event that the Division Commissioner declines to permit the requested transfer, that decision is final and is not subject to appeal to the Girls Coordinator, the Boys Coordinator, the Board or any Officer of the Club. In the event that the Division Commissioner approves the requested transfer, the Interleague Coordinator must approve the transfer before it can be implemented. In the event that the Interleague Coordinator declines to permit the transfer, that decision is subject to appeal to the Executive Committee. The decision of the Executive Committee is final and is not subject to appeal to the Board. Each Interleague Team will be entitled to one transfer per season.
